The Distinguished Service Award is presented to a SEANC member in recognition of cumulative service and active support to the association. Nominees will be those persons who, **year after year**, work to promote SEANC's goals and objectives, serving in whatever capacity asked of them. Nominees are anticipated to be persons whose involvement and presence have left a lasting mark on the association. A member of any district may submit nominations for Distinguished Service, and the Awards Committee will determine the winner. **New restrictions:** (1) **Members may not nominate the same individual in more than one category per year.** (2) **Award recipients are not eligible to win the Distinguished Service Award two years in a row.**
