SEANCE 2022 Legislative Victories

- » 3.5% pay increase for most state employees.
- » 4% one-time supplement for retirees.
- » Minimum wage increase for non-certified school employees to \$15 per hour.
- » Longevity pay maintained for active state employees.
- » Protection of employees personnel records.
- » State Health Plan was fully funded. No premium increase for the fifth consecutive year.
- » Teachers & State Employees Retirement system fully funded. Employer contribution is now 17.38%.
- » Opportunity for employees to use or cash in special bonus leave benefits that accrued.
