DUE'S NEWS

The last time SEANC had a dues increase was 2006-2007 to 2010-2011. Beginning on April 1, 2017, dues are going to increase \$5.00 for all members. Retiree members dues will be \$10.00 and active members will be \$14.00 per month.

Like others, I voted against the dues increase at the Retiree Council, the Board of Governors and at the SEANC Convention along with our district.

At the SEANC Convention, I presented two amendments to the dues increase for \$2.00 for active employees and retirees. Both of the amendments were voted down. I want to thank our own Sandra Bristol, Johnny Burnette from District 5 and Jerry from District 4 for speaking in favor of my amendments. No other members spoke up against the dues increase.

SEANC's IT computer system is over 30 years old and is not compatible with all that SEANC is doing for its members. The dues increase will help with: the upgrade of a new IT system that could exceed one million dollars; hire possible new staff to deal with the bank draft program and to build up our reserves, which is below recommended levels. SE-ANC's IT computer system program is one of only fifty in the world.

Retirees make up about 36% of our members; it costs the same for SEANC to service a retiree as an active member. SEANC represents us in Raleigh. Without them we would lose a lot or all of our benefits.
